- ☐ Time expressed in digital form.

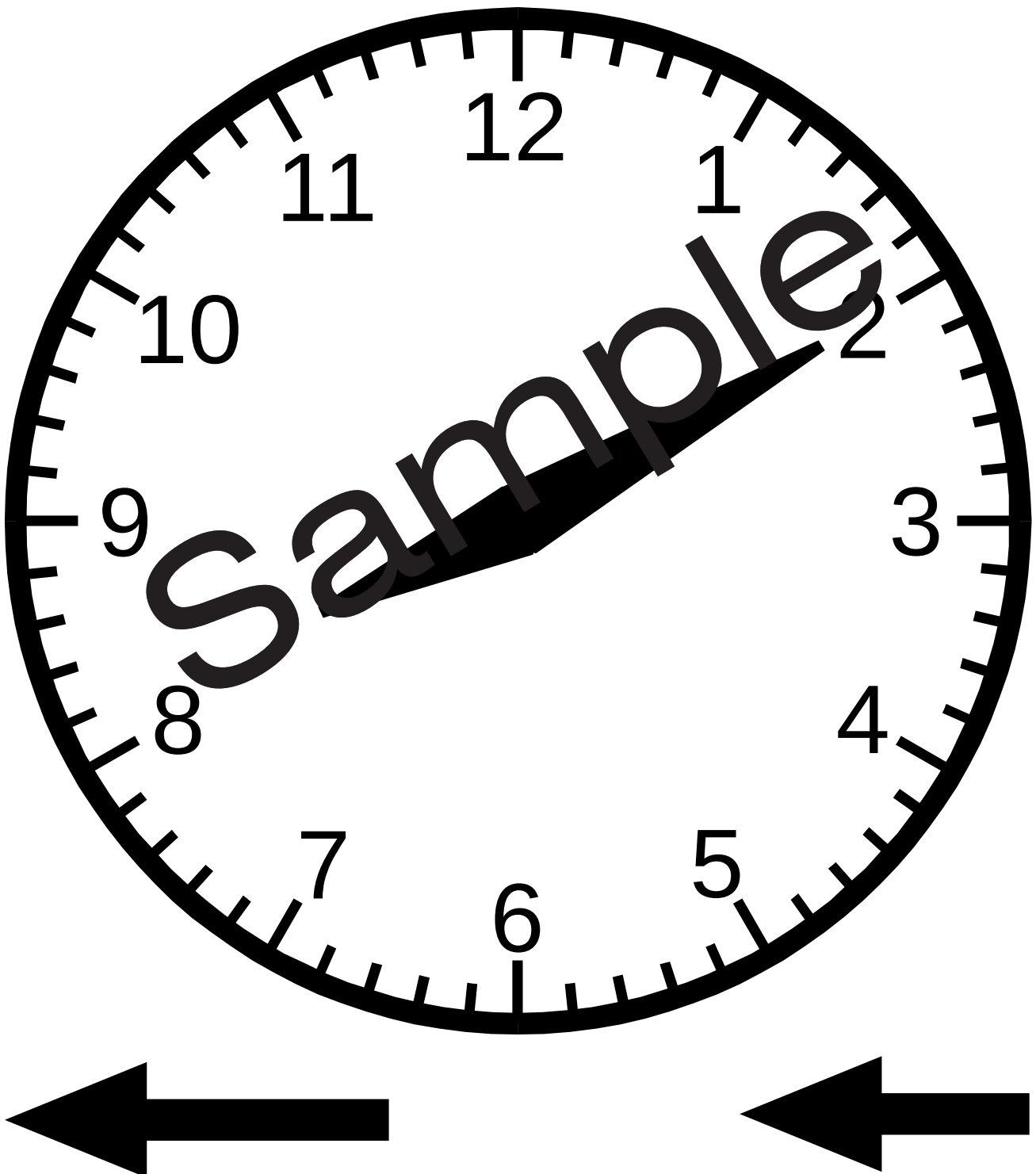

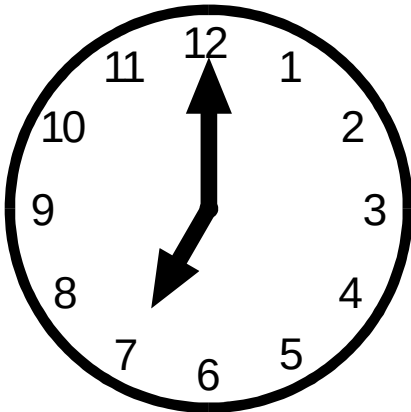
Time - On The Hour (1)



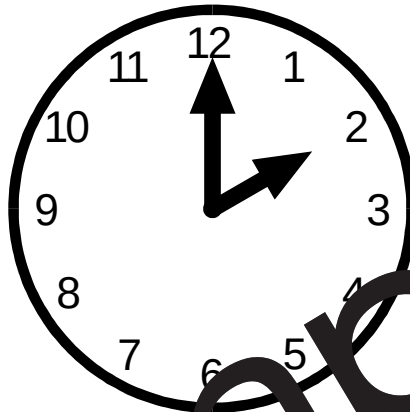
This clock says **4 o'clock** or **4:00**.

The long hand always points to the 12 on the o'clock. The shorter hand points to the hour that it is.

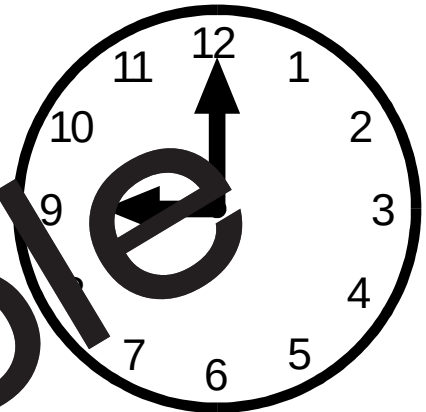

Time - To The Nearest 5 Minutes (1)

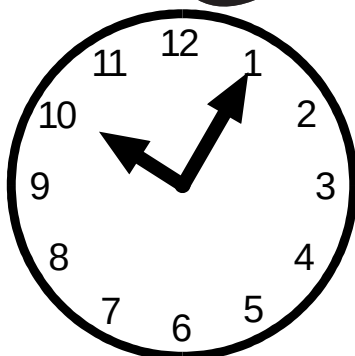
- On a clock face each number represents 5 minutes of time. This is shown by the long hand.



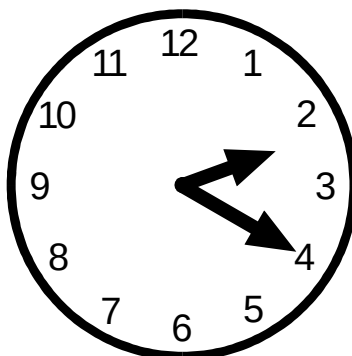
1	= 5 mins
2	= 10 mins
3	= 15 mins
4	= 20 mins
5	= 25 mins
6	= 30 mins
7	= 35 mins
8	= 40 mins
9	= 45 mins
10	= 50 mins
11	= 55 mins
12	= 60 mins

The small hand points to the hour and the numbers are read as the hour, e.g. 3 = 3 o'clock.

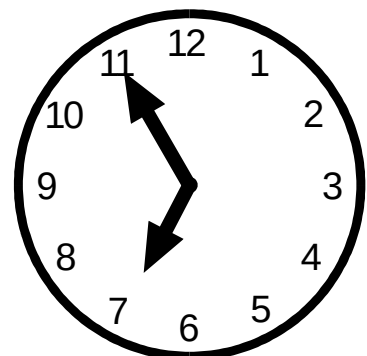

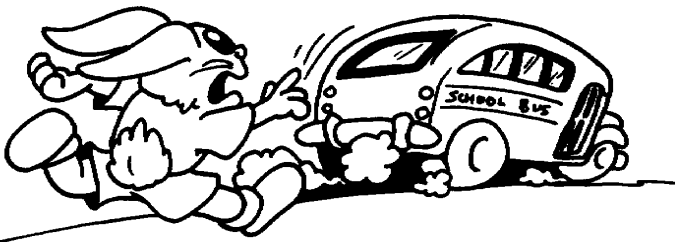

Note: The time is always read with the hour being the last number the small hand has passed.

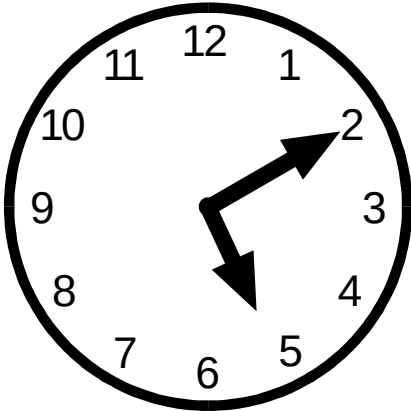
E.g. In example number 3, even though the small hand is nearer the 7, because it is nearly 7 o'clock, the actual time is 6:55 because 6 o'clock was the last hour passed.
