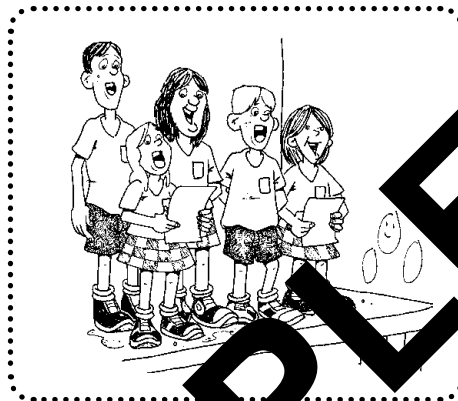
What is a Group?

A group is two or more people who share the same characteristics or interests.

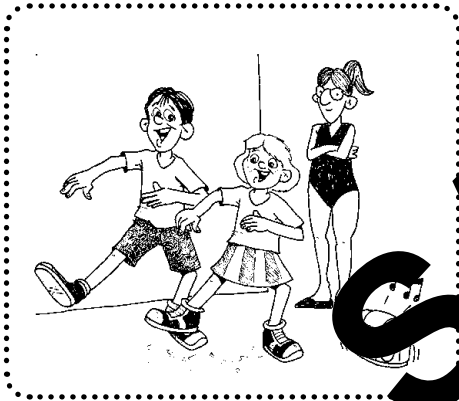
