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Procedure 1:

How to Grow Seeds

Read this procedure.


What you need:

- a saucer
- cotton wool

- bird seed
- water in a small jug

How to do it:

- 1. Place cotton wool on a saucer
- 2. Water the cotton wool so that it is damp
- 3. Sprinkle bird seed on top of the amp cotton wool
- 4. Move the saucer to a work sunny area
- 5. Check it every day
- 6. Add more water so that the cotton wool is damp
- 7. Watch the little green shoots come up after a few days
